

How to write a winning application

What makes an award-winning application?

1. Tell your story. Be sure to paint a full picture of the firm's achievements—even if it means getting back to the basics, such as why you became a lawyer in the first place or what you did in the past.
2. Tie it all together. When sharing your legal journey and all the great things your firm has achieved over the past year, make sure your firm's mission and outcomes clearly connect to the category you are applying for.
